



Clay Classes

Beginning Clay Class using low fire clay

Students will make a pinch pot and a coil pot under Kat's guidance. This is a hand building class which covers the basics of wedging, tips on different kinds of clay, firing tips, and getting used to working with clay that is fired in a kiln. Each piece will be ready for firing as soon as it dries. There will be a follow up class for glazing your pieces. After the final firing, the glazed pots can be picked up and taken home.

Please wear clothes that can get dirty, tie your hair back, and keep in mind that shorter manicured finger nails will help you make a better clay pot!

Each class runs about two hours.

\$150 – for 6 classes. Includes all firings and Intermediate & Throwing On The Wheel.

Intermediate & Throwing on the wheel

This is a continuation of clay work using advanced hand building techniques such as slab work, texture application, glazing techniques, and throwing on the potter's wheel.

Because of the nature of this kind of clay that is fired in a kiln, the student must commit to at least a six week time period coming at least once a week to work on your pieces.

\$300 – For six weeks, which can be paid in \$50 increments each week. Includes all instruction, clay, glazes and firings. Includes 3 hours extra studio time to work on your own.
